

Wolverine Skyhawks Club Field Rules  
AMA Charter #1514

1. You must be a current A.M.A. member and follow the A.M.A. safety code (The Academy of Model Aeronautics). Pilots must be members of the Wolverine Skyhawks or a guest of a full member. (Exception: Events where other AMA members are invited)
2. ( 72 Mhz) Your A.M.A. card with the club identification sticker must be posted at the frequency board while flying.\*
3. ( 72 Mhz) You must have in your possession, the frequency pin covering your radio frequency before turning on your transmitter and you must have your transmitter's frequency identified with the numbers visible on the antenna\*
4. Parking – All vehicles (including trailers) shall be parked so that the tires remain on the established parking area. Vehicles must stay on established road / driveways /parking areas. No driving on the grass areas of the landfill. Gate must remain closed and locked except when members are present. Gate must be open when members are present. Do not leave padlock open even when gate is open.
5. There is to be no flying over the pit area or **behind the flight line**. The“Flight Line” is defined as a line extending indefinitely in both directions along the West edge of the fabric runway. **All flying shall remain within the boundaries of the landfill**. (West of the tree line) and South of Platinum Drive.
6. Mufflers are required on all 2 cycle motors larger than .051 cubic inch and all motor noise is to be kept as low as possible. < 96 db @ 20’\*\*
7. **Hours of operation – 8AM – 8 PM.\*\*\*** There is to be no noise before 9:00 AM . ( Sunday – 1:00 PM ) **All flying shall cease and property vacated by 8:00 PM**. \*\*\* Noise being defined as fuel powered aircraft. Electric and rubber power is OK.
8. No **alcoholic beverages** at the field. **No smoking** anywhere on the property.
9. The driveway speed limit is defined as slow enough to keep the dust to a minimum.
10. Always practice courteous behavior.
11. There is to be no power taxiing into the pit area.

\*If no frequency board at the field, you must notify the other pilots that you are flying 72MHz and coordinate with any other members flying 72MHz.

\*\* Be considerate of the church services until 1 on Sunday. If there is any question that your plane is “too Noisy”, please don’t fly it at the Beltline field.

\*\*\* Our license currently requires us to vacate the property by the earlier of sunset or 8:00 PM
